### Grace Peters

Grace M. Peters, 91, of Aurora succumbed to congestive heart failure on Wednesday, August 2, 2017, at Florence Health Services in Florence, WI. Aptly named, she lived with grace and quiet joy every day. An independent, private person, she faced life's difficulties employing the strength and dignity fueled by her religious faith. Grace's twinkling eyes revealed her healthy sense of humor, and she had a ready laugh. Her companionship, deep understanding of human nature, and astute observations will be missed.

Grace was born on November 21, 1925, to William and Lena (Engel) Kanter in Calumet County, WI. After graduating from Brillion High School, she moved to Milwaukee where she met Gilmore Peters. They married in Brillion on May 1, 1948. Grace lived and worked in the city until 1981, when she and Gil moved to Fence, WI. In 2010, eight years after Gil's passing, she relocated to Aurora. Grace was a long-time member of Our Redeemer Lutheran Church at Kingsford and served on LWML.

Survivors include one daughter, Lynda, of North Carolina, three grandchildren, Jason (Teresa) Peters, John (Lora) Aberle, and Jeff (Joe Rauch) Aberle; seven great-grandchildren and three great-great-grandchildren.
