Greg Russell Carlson, 55, of Sheboygan, Wis., formerly of Iron Mountain, died Sunday, Jan. 17, 2011, at his home in Sheboygan.

He was born Oct. 25, 1955, in Iron Mountain, son of Russell Carlson and the late Joyce (Skoog) Carlson. He graduated from Iron Mountain High School in 1974 and later earned an associate degree in wastewater management from Bay College.

Greg lived in White Pigeon, Mich. until 1978 and then moved to Sheboygan, Wis. where he has lived since that time. He worked as a wastewater engineer in both White Pigeon and Sheboygan prior to retiring due to ill health.
