Harold L. Dilley, 89, of Belgium, WI, formerly of Spread Eagle, died Sun. July 27, 2014 at Heritage Skilled Nursing Home in Port Washington, WI. He was born in Marinesco, MI, on April 28, 1925, the son of the late Donald Dilley and Marie Wilber Anderson.

Harold graduated from Florence High School in 1943. He served as a pilot during World War II in the U.S. Army Air Corps.

Harold married Dorothy Anderson on June 15, 1946 at Bethlehem Lutheran Church in Florence, WI. The couple moved to Milwaukee where Harold worked for Schiltz Brewing Co. for thirty-five years. He retired in 1982 as the quality control supervisor. Harold and Dorothy moved back to Spread Eagle where they managed the Chapin Heights apartments for four years, before moving to Belgium. They also spent eleven winters in Florida. The couple celebrated sixty-eight years of marriage this year.

Harold was a member of the Florence American Legion Post #211 and Bethlehem Lutheran Church. He enjoyed woodworking, cabinet making, and traveling with his travel trailer.

He is survived by his wife Dorothy, one son Melvin (Diane) Dilley of Oak Creek, WI, one daughter Debra (Michael) Jakus of Milwaukee, five grandchildren, 8 great grandchildren, a brother-in-law Roland Anderson, and many nieces and nephews.

Harold was preceded in death by his brother Melvin Dilley in 1944 and his stepfather Sherman Anderson.
