Harriet A. Goodchild, 68, of Iron Mountain died unexpectedly on Sunday, October 23, 2011 at her home. She was born March 15, 1943 in Iron Mountain, daughter of the late Edward and Marguerite (Stokes) Learned, and granddaughter of Hattie Stokes, who raised her.

Harriet was a 1961 graduate of Iron Mountain High School. Just last weekend she celebrated her 50th class reunion with her classmates. On March 14, 1964 she married Larry Goodchild at Trinity United Methodist Church and they made their home in Iron Mountain.

She was very dedicated to her job. Her work at the Crystal Lake Community Center will be long remembered, having been there 32 years, spending the last 20 years as Director.

She was an innovative seamstress, artist and collector who shared her talent for making gifts, crafts and costumes with all who knew her, especially her grandchildren. Her ability to find beauty in, and transform antiques and collectibles into lovely and useful décor was evident in her lifelong home, where everyone was always welcome.
