Helen M. Mott, 87, of Kingsford, went to be with her Savior on Friday, Nov. 24, 2017 at Freeman's Nursing and Rehabilitation Community. She was born on July 1, 1930 in Borup, MN, the daughter of the late Helmer and Minnie (Dahl) Eastvold.

Helen was a Registered Nurse. She worked as an Obstetrics Nurse at Dickinson County Memorial Hospital and as the school nurse for Iron Mountain Public Schools.

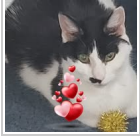
