



Herman "Butch" Reed

Herman R. "Butch" Reed, 74, of Niagara, passed away on Thursday, April 12, 2012 at St. Vincent Hospital in Green Bay.

He was born January 14, 1938 on the Stockbridge Reservation in Gresham, WI, son of the late James and Martha (Herzog) Reed. Butch was a U.S. Navy veteran, serving from 1956 to 1960. He married Elizabeth "Liz" Marcus on November 26, 1960 in Vintondale, PA. Butch was a mechanic by trade, obtaining a degree in automatic transmissions from Northern Michigan University in 1980. He was employed for several years at Machus Service Station in Kingsford and at Arco Service Station in Pembine. Butch also drove school bus for the Pembine School District, worked with his wife at the Port Restaurant, did roofing jobs, and worked at Grede Foundry for a few years among various other small jobs. His family was his number one priority and he did whatever was necessary to make ends meet. Butch was a car "nut" and especially liked older model and antique cars, tractors and pretty much anything with an engine. He enjoyed listening to and singing old country music songs. Butch always told his children, "No matter what happens in life, keep on singing." He also enjoyed watching Westerns on TV and reading novels by his favorite author, Louie LaMour. Butch was very fond of children and was always willing to help out anyone in need. He loved time spent with his family, especially his grandchildren.
