Ivy Pearl Lee, 92, of Iron Mountain, was called home by her Lord and Savior on Friday, Aug. 6, 2010 at HCR ManorCare in Kingsford with her family by her side.

She was born on Aug. 4, 1918, in Iron Mountain, daughter of the late Stephen and Ella (Perkins) Tremain. She was a lifelong resident of Iron Mountain, and the last surviving member of her family. Ivy attended the Iron Mountain schools.

She married William H. Lee on June 15, 1942, and he preceded her in death on Oct. 3, 1978. She was a member of the First United Methodist Church for many years.

She enjoyed ceramics, reading, traveling, and sleeping. She loved going to camp, trips to the casino, bingo, and her dogs.

She was a wonderful wife, sister, mother, grandmother and friend. She warmed your heart with her smile, and was a very giving person. She loved her family very much and you could not ask for a better mother or mother-in-law.
