KINGSFORD - Jack F. Pesavento, 94, of 945 East Hoadley Ave., Kingsford, passed away on Tuesday, Aug. 18, 2009, at Maryhill Manor Nursing Home in Niagara following a long illness.

Jack was born Jan. 5, 1915, in Iron Mountain, son of the late Ferdinand and Therese (Feeley) Pesavento. He was a U. S. Army veteran and served in the Philippines during World War II.

Jack married Margaret Trevillian on June 11, 1938, at Immaculate Conception Church in Iron Mountain. He worked for Keebler as a district sales manager for 30 years before retiring in 1972. Jack and Margaret moved to Green Bay in 1959, due to a business promotion and resided there for eight years. They then moved to Norway Lake where they lived for 35 years before moving to Kingsford.
