



## Jacqueline Emma Kate Sheldon

November 30, 1928 - October 22, 2014

Jacqueline Emma Kate Sheldon, 85, of Kingsford, formerly of Felch, died Wednesday, October 22, 2014 at Dickinson County Memorial Hospital. She was born November 30, 1928 in Felch, the daughter of the late Edward and Annie (Dixon) Lantz.
