Janet “Jan” Fiorazo, 93, of Kingsford passed away Tuesday, June 25, 2024, at Evergreen Assisted Living in Kingsford.

Jan was born December 23, 1930, in Iron Mountain, MI, daughter to the late Thomas and Angeline (Smalter) DeMille. She graduated from Menominee High School before obtaining her Bachelor’s of Art Degree in music and elementary education and a Master’s of Art Degree in education from Northern Michigan University. She married Arthur Fiorazo August 8, 1953, in Menominee; he preceded her in death in 1987.

Jan was an elementary teacher with Niagara Public Schools for 4 years and with Breitung Township Schools for 27 years before retiring in 1987. She volunteered at St. Vincent De Paul Store and was a member of UCT, Pine Grove Country Club, the Women’s Club, Lady Elks, MARSP, AARP, First Lady 1992, MEA, NEA and St. Mary Queen of Peace Catholic Church in Kingsford.
