Janice "Jan" Milligan, 80, of Foster City, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, March 16, 2011.

She was born on Sept. 4, 1930 in Detroit, daughter of the late Stephen and Margaret "Peg" (Murray) Charlevoix. She moved to Hardwood at the age of 11 and has been a resident ever since. She attended school in Felch, graduating from Felch High School in 1948.

She married Pat Milligan on Nov. 26, 1949, in Foster City, and spent nearly 62 wonderful years together.

Jan worked for the United States Postal Service as the Postmaster in Foster City for 20 years, retiring in 1990.

She was a member of St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Foster City. She loved flowers, birds, reading, cooking, baking and crossword puzzles in her spare time. She was also a member of the Letter Carriers Association and Postal Auxiliary.
