Jim "Ritz" Ritzenhein, 84, of Vulcan followed his wife Home on Feb. 26, 2025, from St. Vincent Hospital in Green Bay, WI.

Jim was born on March 19, 1940, in Grand Rapids, MI, son of the late Gerard and Mary Lou (Huxoll) Ritzenhein. He graduated from Sparta High School in 1958.
