John D. Beaulieu, Sr. 74, of Iron Mountain, passed away on Saturday, February 10, 2024 at UP Health System - Marquette after a courageous battle against cancer.

He was born July 21, 1949 in Farmington, Maine, son of the late Edward and Madolyn (Richards) Beaulieu. John graduated from Jay High School in 1967. He was a Korean War Veteran of the United States Army, serving as a Military Policeman and K9 handler. John married L. Louise L'Italien on August 21, 1971 in Wilton, ME. He was employed with International Paper in Jay, ME for 20 years prior to transferring to the Quinnesec paper mill in 1989. John retired from the mill in 2002.
