John E. "Jack" Henning, 58, of Iron Mountain, passed away Friday, May 7, 2010, at Dickinson County Healthcare System.

Jack was born September 15, 1951, in Stambaugh, Mich., son of Victor and Lorraine (Jochem) Henning. He graduated from Florence High School with the class of 1969 and attended college for two years.
