FELCH - John E. Merrill, 74, of Felch died Thursday, July 13, 2006, at Dickinson County Memorial Hospital in Iron Mountain.

John was born Sept. 20, 1931, in Portland, Maine. He was the son of the late Everett and Hattie (Mayberry) Merrill. John lived in Maine for 38 years. He moved to Sault Ste.
