



John "Jack" Stolarski

John "Jack" Stolarski, 71, of Spread Eagle, passed away on Monday, June 27, 2016 at Bellin Hospital in Green Bay, WI.

Jack was born September 13, 1944 in Yuma, AZ, son of the late Edward and Rose (Spsychalski) Stolarski. He graduated from Brother Rice High School, Chicago, IL in 1962 and then attended Ferris State University graduating in 1969 from the School of Pharmacy. While at Ferris, Jack was a member of Kappa Psi Fraternity and was president of the local chapter of the American Pharmaceutical Association (APHA).

Jack met his wife of 45 years, Sandra Daniels Stolarski, while in college and they married on June 26, 1971 at St. Mary Queen of Peace Catholic Church in Kingsford.

He and Sandy lived in Frankfort, IL until moving to Kingsford in 1990. Jack owned and operated the Brementowne Drug Store in Tinley Park, IL for many years. Jack continued his work as a pharmacist in the Iron Mountain-Kingsford area retiring from TDS (The Drug Store) in 2009.

He was an active member and past president of the Rotary Club of Tinley Park.

Jack was involved in the Badwater Ski-ers while his children were participating. Family was the most important thing in Jack's life. He was extremely proud of his children and grandchildren and enjoyed nothing more than time spent with them whether it be at his home or his cottage at Spread Eagle.

He is survived by his wife, Sandy; two children, Jason (Katie) Stolarski of Petoskey, MI and Jennifer (Nick) Anderson of Traverse City, MI; four grandchildren, Jayden & Jenna Stolarski and Ella & Nora Anderson; two sisters, Donna Leonardo of Somerset, MA and Barbara (Gary) Marek of Lemont, IL; brothers-in-law, Dennis, John and Greg Daniels and their families; plus many nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his father-in-law, Gilbert Daniels, and a brother-in-law, Dr. Eduardo Leonardo.
