John Westbrook Sullivan, 92, of Kingsford passed away on Saturday, Sept. 30, 2023, in his home.

He was born in Grand Rapids, MI, on Feb. 16, 1931, son of the late John and Helen (DeGraw) Sullivan. John graduated from Nashville H.S. in 1949.
