John A. Yourzak, 97, of Iron Mountain, died Thurs. Jan. 1, 2015 at Marquette General Hospital. He was born on Nov. 10, 1917 in Little Falls, MN, "Lindbergh's Hometown", the son of the late Joseph and Hattie (Nowak) Yourzak.

John graduated from Little Falls High School. He was a radio man for the US Coast Guard, serving for five years during World War II. He was a life member of the V.F.W and a member of Immaculate Conception Catholic Church. John enjoyed trout fishing and downhill skiing.
