KINGSFORD - Joseph W. Konopacke, 75, of 825 Brookfield St., Kingsford, died Monday, May 12, 2003, at Dickinson County Memorial Hospital in Iron Mountain.

Joe was born March 24, 1928, in Iron Mountain, son of the late Edmund and Stella (Beauparlant) Konopacke. He was a 1946 graduate of Iron Mountain High School.
