Joseph Russell Reddinger, Sr., 84, of Kingsford, passed away suddenly on Sunday, August 19, 2012, at the home of his grandson.

Joe was born May 13, 1928 in Clarion, Pennsylvania, son of the late Russell and Mary (Zagst) Reddinger. He was a United States Army Veteran. On November 19, 1949, Joe married Lorraine Struebing at Mount Olive Lutheran Church in Iron Mountain. He was employed by Keebler Foods for many years as a sales representative, retiring in 1990. Joe was a member of Mount Olive Lutheran Church and Oak Crest Golf Club. Joe coached little league for several years, and enjoyed golfing, bowling, and following his children and grandchildren in sports.
