



Kathleen "Kathy" Lanthier

July 27, 1934 - December 16, 2018

Kathleen E. "Kathy" Lanthier, 84, of Niagara, passed suddenly on Sunday, Dec. 16, 2018 at Dickinson County Memorial Hospital in Iron Mountain.

Kathy was born July 27, 1934 in Green Bay, WI to the late Leonard and Teresa (Blotz) Koehler. She was raised on a farm outside Hilbert, WI, along with seven brothers and sisters, the oldest of whom passed away as a child when Kathy was six years old.

Kathy attended school in Hilbert and graduated from Hilbert High School in 1952. She later attended Holy Family School of Nursing in Manitowoc, WI where she received her nursing degree in 1955.

After a few years she moved to the Iron Mountain area where she was employed at the Veterans Administration Medical Center in Iron Mountain as a nurse. She began working at Maryhill Manor in Niagara as a nurse in 1969. She retired from Maryhill after 32 years, but later returned to work there for several years on a part-time basis.

She was married to Franklin Lanthier on June 14, 1958 and together they had seven children.

She will be remembered for her kindness, sense of humor, and love for her family. For many years she held family dinners at her home every Sunday. She was known for her meat pies, pasties, chicken, meatloaf, sweet bread and poppy seed breads. She loved watching sporting events and going to eat

at her favorite restaurant, A&W in Iron Mountain.

She had a very strong faith in God and was a member of St. Anthony Catholic Church in Niagara for many years. She attended services at Maryhill Manor where she was a resident for the past two years.

Kathy is survived by her children, Mark (Tammie) Lanthier of Niagara, Michael Lanthier of Quinnesec, Marguerite "Maggie" Lanthier of Niagara, Carol (Dale Warren) Uren of Kingsford, Donald "D.J." 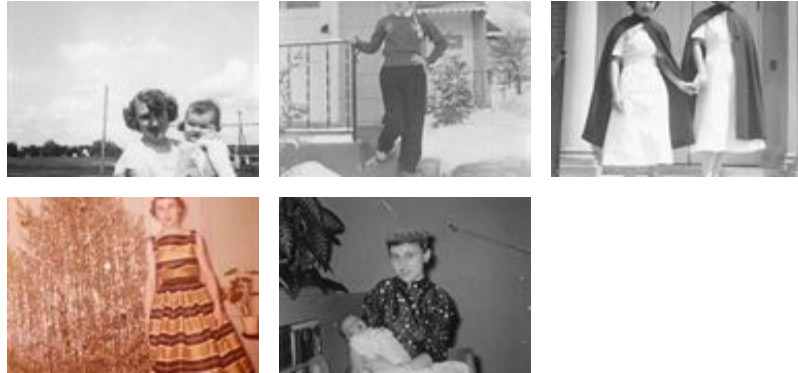
