Keith C. Granger, 86, of Iron Mountain passed away Sunday, Nov. 15, 2020 at his home surrounded by loved ones.

Keith was born July 19, 1934, in Iron Mountain, MI, son of the late Vincent and Edythe (Brynoff) Granger. He was a 1952 graduate of Iron Mountain High School and served during the Korean War in the U.S. Navy. Keith married Genean Lindberg on March 7, 1970 in Iron Mountain and she preceded him in death on March 17, 2019. He was a salesman for Lorillard Tobacco for over 30 years, retiring in 1992. A lifelong resident of the area, he was a member of the Elks Club and Trinity United Methodist Church. Keith had a keen sense of humor and loved telling jokes. He helped out at Hamm's Service Station and enjoyed hunting, fishing, and spending time at camp.
