Kenneth Sheldon, 87, of Felch, died Tues. Jan. 11, 2011 at Freeman Nursing and Rehabilitation Community. He was born on April 28, 1923 in Elmwood, WI, the son of the late Richard and Caroline (Gasteyer) Sheldon.

He served in the U.S. Navy during World War II. He married Jacqueline "Jackie" Lantz on June 28, 1947 at Zion Lutheran Church in Metropolitan. The couple lived in Detroit for 21 years before moving back to Felch. Kenny had a strong work ethic and worked as a carpenter.
