Larry D. Cuggino, 67, of 112 Withworth Ave. in Kingsford, passed away Sunday, July 25, 2010, at his son's home in Rapid City, S.D., surrounded by his family.

Larry was born on June 4, 1943, in Iron Mountain. He graduated from Kingsford High School and has been a lifelong resident of this area. Larry served eight years in the United States Army during the Vietnam War and was honorably discharged as a staff sergeant in 1968.
