January 21, 1936 - November 21, 2018

Larry “Flip” Flaminio, 82, of Iron Mountain died peacefully on Wednesday, November 21, 2018 at Manorcare Healthcare Services with his family at his side.

He was born January 21, 1936 in Iron Mountain, MI, son of the late Dominic and Hilma (Anderson) Flaminio. Larry was a lifelong resident of Iron Mountain and graduated from Iron Mountain High School in 1954. He served in the U. S. Army during the Korean War.

Larry married Marian Janousek on April 18, 1959 in Quinnesec, MI and together they raised 3 children. He was a member of the American Martyr’s Church, Oak Crest Golf Course, the U.C.T., and a life member of the Iron Mountain Elks Club #700. He was a former member of Pinegrove Country Club.
