IRON MOUNTAIN - Laura L. Wright, 89, of 400 E. Grant St. in Iron Mountain, died Thursday, Aug. 3, 2006 at the Freeman's Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Kingsford.

She was born Aug. 11, 1916, in Oconto Falls, Wis., daughter of the late Taylor and Anna (Laughlin) Grismer. Laura graduated from Kingsford High School in 1933.

She married William Wright on July 14, 1936. He preceded her in death on Aug. 11, 1986. She and her late husband owned and operated Wright's Men's Wear in Iron Mountain for many years before retiring.
