LaVere A. Williams, 92, of East Kingsford died Wed. Dec. 19, 2012 at Iron County Medical Care Facility in Crystal Falls. He was born on Feb. 5, 1920 in Neenah, WI, the son of the late LaVere and Anna Williams.
