



Lawrence "Larry" Mattson

June 13, 1938 - May 22, 2011

Lawrence W. "Larry" Mattson, 72, of Kingsford, formerly of Metropolitan and Marquette, died Sun. May 22, 2011 at Dickinson County Memorial Hospital. He was born on June 13, 1938 in Niagara, WI, the son of the late Walter and Julia (Parera) Mattson.

Larry graduated from Felch High School in 1957 and earned an Associate's Degree from Northern Michigan University in 1977.

He served in the U.S. Army from 1957-1960, being stationed in Ethiopia. From 1961-1963 he worked for the Dickinson County Sheriff's Department. In 1963 he went to work for the Michigan Department of Corrections as a corrections officer at the Marquette Branch Prison and he worked there until his retirement in 1990.

Larry married Katherine "Kay" Anderson in 1964 at Zion Lutheran Church in Metropolitan. The couple moved to Felch after Larry's retirement.

Larry enjoyed hunting, fishing, and being outdoors. He greatly enjoyed spending time with his grandchildren.

He is survived by his wife Kay, two sons Kurt (Wendy) Mattson of Altus, OK and their children Jessica and Ryan, and Scott (Autumn) Mattson and their

children Drew and Evan, two brothers Theodore (Fanny) Mattson of Kingsford and Ronald (Renee) Wicklund of Marquette, two brothers-in-law Gerald (Terri) Wickman of Iron Mountain and John Anderson of Felch, two sisters-in-law Ruth Ann Wicklund of Iron Mountain and Susan Anderson of Felch, one aunt Margaret Pach of Harris, and many nieces, nephews, and cousins.

Larry was preceded in death by one sister Carol Wickman, and two brothers John "Jake" Mattson and Donald Wicklund.
