KINGSFORD - Lee T. Michaud, 64, of Breitung Township, died Sunday, April 13, 2008, at his home.

He was born on June 30, 194, in Iron Mountain, the son of the late Thomas and Helmi (Eckloff) Michaud. Lee graduated from Kingsford High School in 1961 and has been a lifelong resident of this area.

He received his bachelor of science degree in electrical engineering from Milwaukee School of Engineering. Lee worked for Pentair (Niagara of Wisconsin) and Champion International as an electrical engineer in their paper mills.

Lee was preceded in death by his sister, Dawn Whalen.
