IRON MOUNTAIN - Leslie "Les" Brisson, 85, of Iron Mountain, died Monday, Oct. 6, 2008, at the Mount Clemens Regional Medical Center.

He was born Jan. 17, 1923, in Norway, son of the late Walter and Hulda (Danielson) Brisson. He graduated from Norway High School, and went on to serve with the United States Army Signal Corp. during World War II. He, along with his brother Ray, started the Lodal Co. He was vice president and chief executive officer, and served as the chief sales manager of the company until retiring in 1986.

He married Rose Izzo on Sept. 7, 1946, in Iron Mountain. Les was a lifelong resident of the area. He was a member of the Trinity United Methodist Church, the American Legion Post 50, and the Iron Mountain Elks Lodge 700.
