



## Lester Briggs

June 5, 1918 - June 5, 2010

Lester J. Briggs, 92, of Iron Mountain, passed away Saturday, June 5, 2010 at Pinecrest Medical Care Facility in Powers, MI.

He was born on April 8, 1918, in Pentoga, MI, son of the late Watson and Goldie (Reno) Briggs. He graduated with the Kingsford High School class of 1937 and went on to attend college for a year and a half at the Milwaukee School of Engineering. He was a member of the United States Army Air Corp and served our country in World War II. Lester married the former Jeanne Poisson on July 5, 1947. Together they raised three children and enjoyed 38 years of marriage. Lester worked as an agent for Prudential Insurance for 28 years, retiring in 1976. He was an avid reader and enjoyed fishing, bird hunting, gardening and playing pool and cribbage. Les was a selfless individual who volunteered over 3,500 hours at the Veteran's Administration Hospital. He was a member of Saint Mary and Saint Joseph Catholic Church in Iron Mountain, the Knights of Columbus, the American Legion Post 50 and Holy Name Society.

Lester is survived by two sons, Thomas (Mary) Briggs of Maryland and Gary (Nancy) Briggs of Indiana; a daughter, Mary (Tom) Peters of Iron Mountain; one brother, Chester (Evelyn) Briggs of Niagara; and four grandchildren, Ashley and Tom Peters and Dorian and Brandon Briggs.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Jeanne, in 1985.

Visitation will be held on Thursday from 10:00am to 12:00 noon at St. Mary and St. Joseph Catholic Church. Funeral services will follow at 12:00 noon at the church. Fr. Daniel Zaloga will offer the Mass of Christian Burial. Burial will be in Cemetery Park. The Uren-Cooper-Johnson American Legion Post 50 will conduct military graveside honors.
