Livio "Lee" Spigarelli

87, of Iron Mountain passed away on Saturday, Feb. 11, 2012 at his home. He was born on September 18, 1924 in Iron Mountain, son of the late Joseph and Serafina (Angeli) Spigarelli. He attended the Iron Mountain Schools graduating from Iron Mountain High School. He went on to attend Michigan State University. Lee enlisted in the United States Army seeing action during WWII with the 820th Tank Destroyer Battalion. He was a Prisoner of War for 8 months in Germany for which he received the Purple Heart. Lee married Fern Eisemann on August 24, 1946 at the Immaculate Conception Catholic Church in Iron Mountain, she preceded him in death on April 29, 2010. He worked for the Dickinson County Road Commission, and retired after 33 years as Superintendent. He was a member of the V.F.W., the Uren-Cooper-Johnson American Legion Post #50, and the Order of the Purple Heart Chapter #1879. Lee was an avid golfer, and loved hunting and fishing at the camp in Sagola. He was preceded in death by three brothers, Primo, Armond, and John Spigarelli.
