



## Llewellyn "Bing" Miller

June 23, 1936 - May 16, 2016

Llewellyn Jay Miller, known to all as "Bing Miller", 79 of Fairview, Texas, passed away on Monday, May 16, 2016 at his home. He was born on June 23, 1936 in Rhinelander, Wisconsin, son of the late Leon Jay Miller and Vera Audrey Hansen (Miller). He attended school in Rhinelander, Wisconsin, graduating from Rhinelander High School in 1954. He enlisted in the United States Army and was Honorably discharged in 1962. He married Joyce Whitaker in Rhinelander, Wisconsin on September 13, 1958, and had spent more than 57 wonderful years together.

Bing joined the Commercial National Bank of Iron Mountain in 1962 where he retired as Executive Vice President in 1996, and later was Co-Owner and General Manager of Superior Title and Abstract of Iron Mountain from 1996 to 2000. He was a long time avid golfer and board member at Pine Gove Country Club and later at Apache Wells in Mesa Arizona where he was also Club Champion in 2006. Bing enjoyed all sports including racquet ball, skiing, basketball, baseball and of course snowmobiling.

Bing is survived by his loving wife, Joyce Carol Miller of Fairview, Texas; his son, Brian Jay Miller of Fairview, Texas married to Doreen Kay Lucas, with two children son Collin and daughter Callie; Daughter, Tamra Lee Miller (Veldhuizen) of Rochester, Minnesota married to Mark Veldhuizen, with two children son Ryan and daughter Morgan; Daughter, Sherri Carol Miller

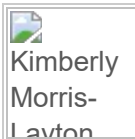

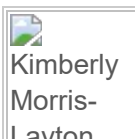
