IRON MOUNTAIN - Lloyd W. Boyle, 83, of 1816 Mary's Way, Kingsford, died Tuesday, Sept. 3, 2002, at his home.

Lloyd was born Sept. 1, 1919, in Painesdale. He was the son of the late William and Alice (Cook) Boyle. He graduated from Calumet High School in 1940.

Lloyd served during World War II with the United States Army in the European, African and Middle Eastern Theatre of Operations.

On Sept. 21, 1946, in Dollar Bay, he married the former Elizabeth Locatelli.

Lloyd worked for the Calumet and Hecla Mining Co. in Calumet and the Atlas Powder Co. in Dollar Bay. He and his wife were residents of Laurium for 23 years. They spent the next 29 years in Green Bay, Wis., where Lloyd worked for National Can, retiring in 1983.
