Lloyd M. Qualley, 81, of Felch, formerly of Iron Mountain, died Friday, Dec. 24, 2010, at Aurora Bay Care in Green Bay, Wis.

He was born April 25, 1929, in Suring, Wis., son of the late Norman and Maude (Rohn) Qualley.

He graduated from Oshkosh High School in 1947 and served in the U.S. Army during the Korean War. He married Charlene Johnson on June 18, 1955 in Iron Mountain at the First Covenant Church. The couple lived in Oshkosh before moving to Iron Mountain in 1971. Lloyd was a licensed builder for Wausau Homes for nine years and owned and operated Lloyd's Magic Mirror, first in Oshkosh and then in Iron Mountain.

Lloyd was a member of First Lutheran Church and a former member of the Dickinson County Air Patrol. He was a certified National Ski Instructor for many years. He was also registered with the U.S. Coast Guard as a licensed boat captain. Lloyd enjoyed hunting, fishing and spending time at his camp with his wife and family.

He is survived by his wife Charlene; two sons, Brain Qualley and Craig Qualley, both of Iron Mountain; two brothers, Tom Qualley of Oshkosh and Jim (Marcia) Qualley of North Chicago; one sister, Bonnie Fisher of Wild Rose,

Wis., five grandchildren, Jon, Rhiannon, Clay, C.J., and Courtney Qualley; three step-grandchildren, Sara Snowdon and Audrey and Brett Sparapani; three step great-grandchildren, Gavin, Whitney, and Eli; and several nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by one brother, Lee Qualley.

Visitation will be Thursday from 10:30 a.m. to 12 noon at First Lutheran Church.

Funeral services will be at 12 noon at the church. Rev. Stephen Cowen will officiate.
