KINGSFORD - Lorette M. Post, 90, of 425 Grant St, Kingsford, died Tuesday, Jan. 4, 2005, at Dickinson County Memorial Hospital in Iron Mountain.

She was born on June 7, 1914, in Lena, Wis., the daughter of the late Roger and Anna (Riha) Burbey.

She was a 1932 graduate of Kingsford High School.

Mrs. Post worked as a telephone operator at Michigan/Wisconsin Bell for 43 years, retiring in 1976.

Lorette was instrumental in organizing the union and served as president of C.W.A. and as a union steward. She was a member of American Martyrs Catholic Church, the Lady Elks and United Commercial Travelers (UCT). She enjoyed dancing, cooking, and entertaining her neighbors with homemade soups and desserts.

She married Forrest Post on June 16, 1934, at St. Mary and St. Joseph Catholic Church. He preceded her in death exactly 30 years earlier on Jan. 4, 1975.
