Lorraine F. Luba, 97, of Kingsford, MI, passed away Sunday, September 22, 2024, at Evergreen Assisted Living in Kingsford.

Lorraine was born November 16, 1926 in Ironwood, MI, daughter of the late Carl and Elizabeth (DesLongchamp) Wahlquist. She graduated from Kingsford High School in 1945 and went on to get technical training to become a pharmacy technician. She worked at Dickinson County Hospital for many years.
