IRON MOUNTAIN - Lorraine V. Massa, 89, of 311 Prospect Ave., Iron Mountain, died Saturday, Sept. 10, 2005, at Dickinson County Memorial Hospital in Iron Mountain.

She was born April 28, 1916, in Iron Mountain, daughter of the late Antonio and Ernestine (St. Arnaud) Lefebvre. Lorraine was a 1934 graduate of Iron Mountain High School and resided in the area her entire life.

She married James A. Massa on May 21, 1937, in Iron Mountain. He preceded her in death on Oct. 3, 1994.

Lorraine worked as a bookkeeper for Paul Electric Co. for many years. She also volunteered at the Iron Mountain Schools hot lunch program for several years. Lorraine was a member of St. Mary and St. Joseph Catholic Church and the Daughters of Isabella. She was an avid reader.
