Lorraine Reddinger, 91, of Kingsford passed away on Friday, March 6, 2019, at Dickinson County Healthcare System in Iron Mountain.

Lorraine was born April 28, 1928, daughter of the late Fred and Sophie (Knudsen) Struebing. She was raised from a young age by her mother and step-father, Gust Maedke.
