FENCE, Wis. - Lorraine Arletta Salczenko Neuens, 68, was received into eternal life on Sunday, Jan. 7, 2007, following a brief stay at Florence Villa.

Lorraine was born on Nov. 22, 1938, to Edward and Katherine Thomas in Fence.

She was active in area Christian women's organizations, Rural Bible Crusades and for many years was a member of Maranatha Assembly of God in Kingsford and later at Fox Valley Christian Fellowship in Kimberly.

She also enjoyed her children and grandchildren and treasured their visits.

Visitation will be held from 3 p.m. to 6 p.m. on Tuesday at Maranatha Assembly of God in Kingsford.

Funeral services will follow at 6 p.m. at the church. Rev. David Wilton and Rev. Terry Wilson will officiate.

Burial will be in the Fence Cemetery.
