Louis E. Moroni, 95, of Kingsford, died Thursday, December 15, 2011 at the Dickinson County Memorial Hospital. He was born July 24, 1916 in Iron Mountain, son of the late Mario and Clara (Valerio) Moroni. Louis was a lifelong resident of this area and graduated from Iron Mountain High School in 1936.
