



## Louise Marek

June 16, 1913 - March 13, 2011

Louise Schupp Marek died at Sunrise Cottages in Rochester, MN in the early morning of the Lord's Day, Sunday March 13, 2011 just three months and three days shy of her 98th birthday. She had resided in Rochester at Madonna Meadows Assisted Living for the past five years.

Louise was born in Iron Mountain, Michigan to Alois Schupp and Rose Richtig. In the course of her long life she married and buried two husbands. Her first marriage was to Guido DeJuliani and ended when he died soon after. Her second marriage was to Vernal Marek, a widower, who came to the marriage with two young stepsons, David and Dean, whom she mothered as her very own for the rest of their lives. For that alone she deserves a higher place in heaven. In addition to managing a household, she co-owned and operated with Vernal a restaurant in Tuscon, Arizona that specialized in pasties and a superette in Cleveland, Ohio.

Louise was preceded in death by both of her husbands, stepson David, and her five siblings Hedwig, Mary, Albert, Anton, and Edna.

She is survived by stepson, Father Dean, step grandsons, Gregory and Anthony (Kathleen) and step great grand daughters, Emma and Grace, together with nieces and nephews of the families of Paul and Mary Farrington, Albert and Elizabeth Schupp, Anton and Louise Schupp, James and Edna
