Lowell "Skip" P. Dennis, 72, of Kingsford, passed away on Sunday, March 6, 2011, at the Dickinson County Memorial Hospital in Iron Mountain after a brief illness.

Skip was born on April 19, 1938, in Hancock, son of Julia (Carlson) and the late Paul Dennis. He attended school in Hancock, graduating from Hancock High School.
