



Margaret A. Bjorkman

Margaret A. Bjorkman, 95, of Niagara, passed away Friday, March 17, 2023, at Marshfield Medical Center-Dickinson of Iron Mountain.

Margaret was born May 10, 1927, in Niagara, WI, daughter of the late Harold and Fleta (Peterson) Schindler. She graduated from Niagara High School in 1945 and was a lifelong resident of the area. Following graduation, Margaret worked at the Kimberly Clark Paper Mill as a roll skinner to earn money for college. She was hired to replace the men that went to fight in WWII. She attended U.W. - Stevens Point for three years and then taught in the Marinette and Laona schools. She married Clarence Bjorkman on Sept. 22, 1951 in Niagara; he preceded her in death in 2017. Margaret was a long-time, active member of Riverside United Methodist Church in Niagara where she taught Sunday School and served on the worship committee. She was also involved with Karen's Food Pantry where she sat on the board. Margaret enjoyed gardening, fishing, camping, reading and sewing.

Margaret is survived by her two sons, Daniel (Joanne) Bjorkman and Robert Bjorkman (Cookie Cazolla); four daughters, Peggy (Kevin) Dick, Carol (Joe) Gallino, Sharon (Robert) Kristoff, and Ellen (John) Allard; a sister, Sharon (Larry) Chick; a brother, Richard (Sondi) Schindler; 20 grandchildren and their families; 14 great-grandchildren; a brother-in-law, Bill (Helen) Bjorkman; and numerous nieces and nephews.

In addition to her husband and parents, she was preceded in death by a brother, DuWayne Schindler.

The visitation will be held on Wednesday, March 22, 2023 from 11:00 am-12:00 noon at the Riverside United Methodist Church in Niagara. A memorial service will follow at 12 noon at the church. Pastor Deb Spira will officiate. Burial will be in the Niagara Cemetery.
