Margery Agnes DeClark, 81, of Kingsford passed away Tuesday, June 7, 2022, at the Pinecrest Medical Facility in Powers surrounded by her children after her long battle of Alzheimer's.

Margery was born September 15, 1940, in Aurora, WI, daughter of the late Glen and Gertrude (Cardinal) Church. She graduated from Kingsford High School, Class of 1957, and married Gary DeClark at Trinity United Methodist Church on September 13, 1957; he preceded her in death in 1999. A lifelong resident of the area, Margery was a certified nurses aide at Maryhill Manor Nursing Home for several years and also owned and operated the North Star Bar in Niagara, along with her husband Gary. She was a former member of Riverside United Methodist Church in Niagara where she enjoyed singing in the choir. She continued her love of singing with the Smile Awhile group and would travel to the various nursing homes to sing to the residents. She was also a member of Les Artiste, a local artist club. Margery loved painting, especially oil painting, and won several awards for her artwork, which she entered in the fair numerous times. She was known for her sense of humor, style, and smile. Marge will be remembered by most people for her heart of gold and kindness. Most importantly, she loved spending time with her family, especially her grandchildren.
