January 25, 1941 - December 4, 2021

Marion J. Bubloni, 80, of Iron Mountain, passed away on Saturday, December 4, 2021, at Abrazo West Hospital in Goodyear, AZ.

Marion was born on January 25, 1941, in Hermansville, MI, daughter of the late John and Ida (Malone) St. Juliana. She was raised in Hermansville and following her graduation from Hermansville High School in 1958 went to work for Norway Gravure. On April 29, 1961, Marion was united in marriage to Mike G.
