Marion Marcella Johnson, 93, of Kingsford passed away Thursday, Sept. 1, 2022, at Freeman Nursing and Rehabilitation Community in Kingsford.

Marion was born March 21, 1929, in Sagola, MI, daughter of the late Elmer and Senia (Palomaki) Johnson. She grew up on her parents farm and from the early age of 12 she enjoyed driving work horses to hill her dad's potatoes. Marion was crowned Potato Queen of Dickinson County in 1945 and graduated from Channing High School in 1946. She married Curtis Johnson on December 27, 1947, at Grace Presbyterian Church in Sagola and he preceded her in death on Oct. 17, 2003. Marion worked for the IM-K Community Schools Day Care Program and was a member of the First Lutheran Church.
