Marjorie C. "Marge" Frankini, 97, a lifelong resident of Iron Mountain until 2014, passed away peacefully on Sunday, November 3, 2019, at the Seasons at Maplewood Center, Maplewood, MN.

Marge was born October 9, 1922, in Iron Mountain, daughter of Lorenzo & Adeline Quadrani. She graduated in 1941 from IMHS. After graduation Marge attended schools in Chicago and Minneapolis with a focus in nursing and medical technology. After returning from Minneapolis, she began working at Frankini Jewelry store and married the boss' son, Art Jr., in 1947.

Marge was very active in the community, serving on both the Iron Mountain school board and Community school board. She was president of the Hospital League and volunteered every Tuesday in the Emergency Room for 40 years.
