Marjorie A. (Marj) Anderson, 84, of 1116 Park Ave. Iron Mountain, died Monday, February 27, 2012 at Dickinson County Memorial Hospital.

She was born on August 20, 1927 in Ripon, WI, one of seven children of the late Charles and Mabel (Lawson) Grahn.
