Marjorie Luella Nicolas, 96, of Iron Mountain, passed away on Thursday, Dec. 24th, 2020, at Dickinson County Healthcare System.

Marjorie "Marge" was born on November 8, 1924, in Iron Mountain, daughter of the late Walter and Margaret "Tootie" (Kesler) Baumler.
